



# Peer Review Design

Good peer review design should help students to become independent learners able to plan, monitor, evaluate and regulate their own learning, independently of the teacher.

*These cards are intended to help staff design peer review in ways that will enable students develop their own assessment and feedback skills and their ability to deal with feedback provided by others. Providing feedback reviews and interpreting feedback reviews will enhance the learning process and will develop essential professional skills.*

- Ensure an atmosphere of trust
- Give practice with criteria
- Require explanations for reviews
- Give practice in holistic appraisals
- Facilitate dialogue around reviews
- Integrate self-reviews
- Provide signposts for quality
- Encourage reflection on received reviews
- Make review a regular activity
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
